

Canary Islands food banks receive fuel cards from Fundación Cepsa

- **Intended for the vehicles the associations use to do their work in the community**
- **This donation stems from the Great Food Drive organized every year throughout Spain**

Fundación Cepsa donated fuel cards to the food banks of Tenerife and Las Palmas de Gran Canaria for the vehicles that both entities use to distribute food to NGOs, soup kitchens, and other assistance centers on the Islands.

This donation arose from the donation campaign the Great Food Drive, which is organized every year by the food banks of Spain. Fundación Cepsa has been participating in the food drive since it began. Cepsa professionals and their families responded to the usual call for volunteers through the *Voluntas* Corporate Volunteer Program with the Foundation's commitment to donate fuel for each volunteer.

Despite the fact that the food banks' last campaign could not be carried out with in-person volunteers to prevent the spread of COVID-19 and they instead provided monetary donations directly and at the cash registers of the collaborating supermarkets, Fundación Cepsa has once again maintained its commitment to support this great cause by donating fuel cards.

In 2020, Fundación Cepsa also donated 70,000 euros to the food banks of the Canary Islands to alleviate the effects of the health crisis, in addition participating as a collaborating entity in the Solidarity Telethon organized in December by the food bank of Tenerife, a massive event resulting in the collection of 25,000 kilos of food.
