Fundación Moeve promotes inclusive volunteering by creating hand prosthetics together with Ayúdame 3D

- A total of 40 Moeve volunteers in San Roque are participating in a volunteering project to create 3D-printed hand prosthetics.
- These prosthetics, created by the NGO Ayúdame 3D, will be offered free of charge to people with disabilities in various countries.

Fundación Moeve joins the NGO Ayúdame 3D to carry out a volunteer program in San Roque focused on the preparation and assembly of 3D-printed prosthetics, aimed at improving the autonomy and quality of life for people with disabilities worldwide.

The activity took place at the San Roque industrial center, where the 40 Moeve volunteers collaborated in the assembly of hand prosthetic components that will subsequently be sent completely free of charge to recipients by the collaborating entity.

The day began with an informative explanation by Ayúdame 3D to raise awareness of the impact that 3D printing technology has on the lives of thousands of people, and how each volunteering gesture contributes to generating real opportunities for inclusion. After the introduction, the volunteers were divided into groups to carry out the process of preparing and assembling the prosthetics following the technical guidelines set by Ayúdame 3D, while participating in a collaborative and enriching experience.

Estrella Blanco, head of fundación Moeve in Cadiz, highlighted the importance of the initiative: "We're closing out this year's fundación Moeve volunteer program with a high-impact and significant activity. It has been incredibly special for everyone to be part of the Ayúdame 3D project and create prosthetics for those in need, an action with a direct impact on the quality of life of individuals. I want to thank all the volunteers who worked with us this year, and all the entities that have allowed us to collaborate on initiatives to improve the lives of people in vulnerable situations, our natural spaces, and our biodiversity.

Through its volunteering program, fundación Moeve promotes the participation of Moeve professionals in volunteer initiatives, awareness campaigns, charitable activities, and social impact projects at different work centers. This volunteer action, focused on the creation of hand prosthetics, is part of fundación Moeve's International Volunteer Day program. The initiative was carried out over two weeks in the various Spanish territories where Moeve is present and saw the participation of 352 volunteers.
